

NOTICE TO PARENTS

The following "Release of Liability Agreement" was created specifically for the Society of Saint Pius X camps, pilgrimages, road trips and outings, and its use has been mandated by our legal counsel. Unfortunately, in this day and age, we live in a litigious world, and the Society of Saint Pius X could be sued for any type of accident which could occur at a camp, pilgrimage, road trip or outing, no matter how unlikely or remote. The following agreement is therefore necessary to protect the Society of Saint Pius X. By signing this agreement, you as parents, should assume the full risk of any accident which could befall your child(ren) at the camp, pilgrimage, road trip or canoe outing referenced below. Parents who do not wish to assume this risk should not sign this agreement, and should not send their child(ren) to the camp, pilgrimage, road trip or outing.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY AGREEMENT

fully recognize, acknowledge and consent to the inherent risks of personal injury in camps, pilgrimages, road trips and outings including, but not limited to those risks which are relatively minor (e.g. cuts, bruises, sunburns, blisters, falls, broken bones, insect bites, muscle strains and sprains, contracting poison ivy or poison oak, etc.), and also including those risks which are less likely to occur, but which can be severe or fatal, (including, but not limited to falling off a cliff, tree or other object; drowning; being involved in a brawl or fight; suffering asphyxiation, an allergic reaction, poisoning, or snake-bite; suffering any emotional distress, fright, trauma, shock, depression, anxiety or any other emotional or psychological disorder; being involved in an automobile accident or other type of motor vehicle or boating accident; being victim to accidental gunshot or arrow-shot, or wound by another weapon or object; suffering burns from fire or chemicals; running into or coming into contact with sharp or dangerous objects; being victim to lightning strike, avalanche, animal attack, or human violence or mischief; or being subjected to an earthquake, tornado, hurricane or other unforeseen or unlikely event.)

We agree to assume the full risk of any injuries including death, damages or loss which we or our child(ren) may sustain as a result of our child(ren) participating in any of the events or activities connected with the camp, pilgrimage, road trip or canoe outing, referenced below. Furthermore, we hereby release, discharge and hold harmless _____, SSPX Orlando Florida d/b/a Saint Thomas More Church, as well as SSPX, and any and every of its subordinates or affiliates, and any and every of the priests, counselors, agents, employees, officers or directors or other staff or personnel (including volunteers) of these entities from any liability or claim of liability, including but not limited to negligence, or failure to supervise; furthermore, this release extends not only to any of the accidents or injuries mentioned in the preceding paragraph, but also to any other conceivable accidents or injuries, including death, any emotional distress, any damages, economic loss, or any intangible loss arising from or relating to events, travel or activities which take place in connection with the pilgrimage

If any word, sentence, paragraph or other part of this agreement is struck down by any court or agency having competent and proper jurisdiction as being either void, illegal, unconscionable, or otherwise, then such action will not have the effect of rendering the entire agreement invalid; instead, the remainder of the agreement will stand and be binding on its own as if no part of the agreement were struck down.
